reimbursement. In 2004, a claims specialist at a Social Security government department told me this. The same issues were transferred to the Illinois Department of Human Services. In 2018, a case worker at the Illinois Department of Human Services told me this grant was for me. The computer indicated that this grant was for me. After this, they suddenly told me my disability. This was not justified and that this was communicated to them. My remuneration and income must be categorized as a regular grant or earned income.
